## **Registration Checklist**

To enroll your student, provide the following documentation:

☐ Birth Certificate
☐ Social Security Card
☐ Immunization Record
☐ Court-Ordered Custody Papers (must provide if your name is not on the birth certificate)
Note: Court order must be signed by the judge: notarized educational/provisional austod
is not accepted by the school system. Only parents listed on the birth certificate or legal
guardians (court-ordered) will be allowed to register a student.
□ <u>FOUR</u> Proofs of Residency:
1.   Parent/guardian's driver's license/ID
Note: License/ID MUST include current physical address within LOJH school zon
2. $\square$ CURRENT electric bill with physical address
3.   additional CURRENT proof of residency
4.   additional CURRENT proof of residency
examples gas, water or garbage bill showing point of service, mortgage
*****If you are renting/leasing a residence or are living with someone else:
1.  \[ \sum \text{You must update your license to reflect the physical address where you are living (call the DMV for instructions).} \]
2.   You must provide a copy of the rental/lease agreement. If you do not have a rental/lease agreement, you must get a residency affidavit completed by a notary (can pick up a copy of the affidavit at school).
3.   CURRENT electric bill with the physical address (can be in the owner's name that is reflected on the rental/lease agreement or residency affidavit)
4. $\square$ One additional <u>CURRENT</u> proof of residency (can be in the owner's name that is
reflected on the rental/lease agreement or residency affidavit); examples—gas, water or garbage bill showing point of service
□ Documents from Previous School
☐ Withdrawal/Drop Form
☐ Most Recent Report Card
☐ Completed Student Information Packet – pick up at LOJH
